### ► cerebrum

- largest part
- used to think, reason, remember
- sorts & stores info.
- receives & sorts info
  - messages from diff. senses go to diff. centers
    - only see, hear, smell etc. when brain interprets the messages
    - see illus. p. 153 of cerebrum's centers
  - other centers control voluntary muscles

### ► cerebellum

- below cerebrum & at back of head
- helps muscles work together
- helps keep balance

### ► medulla

- connects brain to spinal cord
- controls heart rate & breathing
- " involuntary muscles
  - ex. in digestive system
- controls some reflex actions
  - blinking
  - yawning
